Master of Accountancy Program (Distance Learning)

The Master of Accountancy Program requires a total of 30 semester hours: Four “Required” accounting courses, three “Accounting Electives”, and three “Business Electives.” On-campus graduate classes are videotaped, and Distance students receive the lectures on DVD. During fall and spring, classes meet twice a week (Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays) for 1 hours and 15 minutes.

Therefore, Distance students receive two DVDs per week. Distance Learning Master of Accountancy students employed full-time should take no more than two classes per semester during fall and spring.
