Master of Accountancy Program (On-Campus)

The Master of Accountancy Program requires a total of 30 semester hours: Four “Required” accounting courses, three “Accounting Electives”, and three “Business Electives.” During the fall and spring, classes meet twice a week (Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays) for 1 hour and 15 minutes. Summer semester courses are taught in two five-week mini-sessions called 1st and 3rd sessions, and classes meet five days a week for 1 ½ hours per day. POSSIBLE SCHEDULES FOR ON-CAMPUS MAc STUDENTS:

REMEMBER: You must take the 4 required courses, 3 accounting electives, and 3 business electives.

Alabama CPA Exam Candidates: If you enroll summer and plan to sit for the CPA exam as an Alabama candidate, you need to have 150 hours by the end of fall so that you can take Becker CPA Review on-campus spring semester.

Georgia CPA Exam Candidates can now sit for the CPA exam with a bachelor's degree, 120 semester hours and 20 hours of upper level accounting; however, you must complete the 150 hour requirement to include 30 hours of upper level accounting before becoming certified and licensed. Therefore, you are eligible to sit in Georgia upon completion of your BSBA in Accountancy. However, you don't want to sit until you have taken your fall classes.
